**Sample Honors Compact**

In addition to existing course requirements, students completing an honors compact for ACG 3341 (Cost Accounting) must satisfactorily complete the following:

1. Attend a minimum of three (3) Accounting Student Association or Institute of Internal Auditors meetings and write an executive summary for each of the meetings attended.
2. Prepare a brief paper (about 3 pages) comparing decision making based on three alternative accounting methods: Full Absorption, Variable, and Through-put. The student will read the novel *The Goal* to fully understand this assignment.
3. Complete a minimum of three (3) of the following five (5) options:
  - a. Write a report on managerial accounting careers. Assume that you are preparing the report for prospective accounting students.
  - b. Write a report on the process and requirements for becoming a Certified Management Accountant or a Certified Internal Auditor
  - c. Write a report on on-campus recruiting resources. Assume that you are preparing the report for prospective accounting students.
  - d. Write a report on business and business casual attire. Assume that you are preparing the report for prospective accounting students.
  - e. Write a report of discussion between you and a professor or faculty advisor involving your professional development or career.
