- Earn a grade of 'B' or better in all coursework taken while a student in the ASP
- Participate in professional development, networking and ASP events as instructed
- Follow appropriate dress code for all events
- Check email at least daily when school is in session and at least weekly during semester breaks
- Meet all deadlines
- Complete all ASP requirements within four semesters
