Dr. Klein is the Director, Critical Care Surgery and Trauma Unit at the Sheba Medical Center in Israel. He is Chairman of the Israeli Trauma Society, Director of the Department of Acute Care Surgery and Trauma at Kaplan

Medical Center, serves as a member of the Israeli National Committee on Mass Casualty of the Ministry of Health, and is a lecturer of general surgery at the Hebrew University School of Medicine in Jerusalem.

Additionally, Dr. Klein serves as the Commander of the Israeli Air Force Trauma Unit for Special Operations since 2002. Dr. Klein has published more than 40 peer-reviewed articles and six chapters in various textbooks. Dr. Klein is also a guest lecturer and keynote speaker at numerous scientific and medical conferences in Israel and abroad.
