

# Florida voters losing confidence in Trump's handling of coronavirus pandemic





Florida voters' assessment of President Donald Trump's handing of the <u>new coronavirus</u> has declined significantly with the visibly widespread effects of the pandemic now in their

third month. A poll released Friday by Florida Atlantic University shows 45% of Florida voters approve of the job Trump is doing in handling the spread of the coronavirus in the United States and






