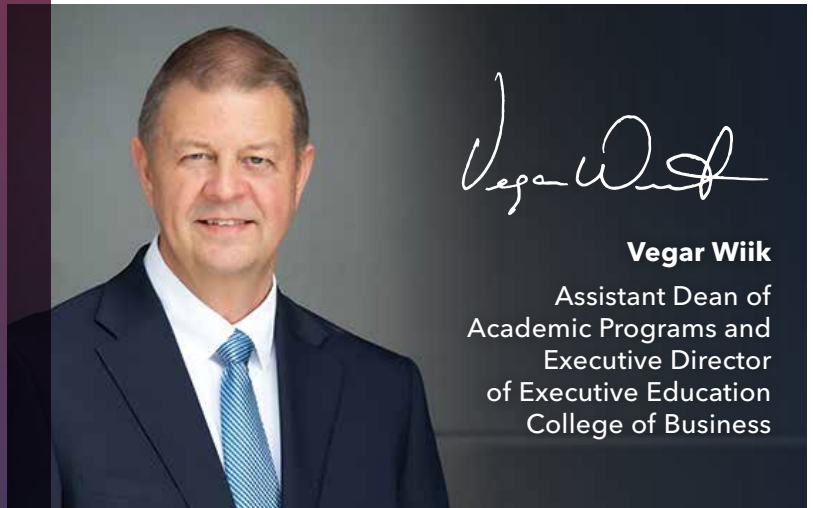

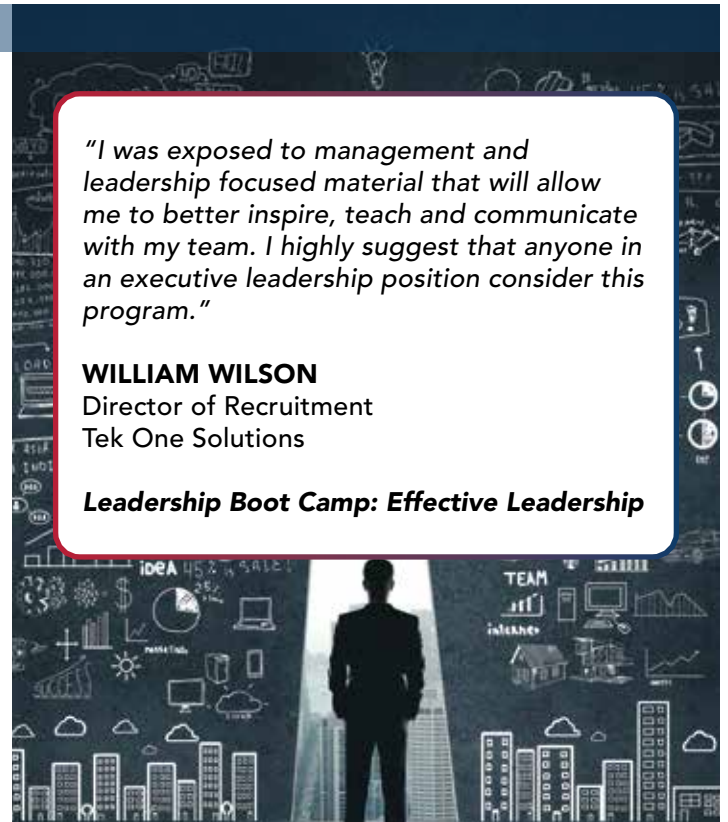

ENTRY-LEVEL CERTIFIED INTERNAL AUDITOR SALARY

Starting out as an entry-level internal auditor, your salary will likely range between \$50,000 and \$70,000 annually. With a CIA certification under your belt, you'll quickly stand out from your peers who lack certification. Non-certified internal auditors generally earn less—sometimes by 25% or more.

After a few years of experience, many CIAs move up to roles like Senior Internal Auditor or Internal Auditing Manager. These positions command higher salaries, typically between \$80,000 and \$110,000. Senior auditors take on more responsibility, such as leading internal audits, mentoring audit teams, and conducting complex risk assessments. This is where the CIA designation really starts to pay off. ¹

Advance your accounting career with flexible, career-focused programs designed for today's professionals. Whether you're pursuing a Professional Accounting Certificate, completing required CPA credit hours, or earning Continuing Professional Education (CPE) credits to maintain your license, our courses provide the

practical knowledge and credentials you need to stay competitive. Learn from experienced faculty, strengthen your technical expertise, and meet your professional requirements—on a schedule that works for you. Take the next step toward growth and advancement in the accounting profession.

CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT (CPA) CREDITS

Students can take courses to accumulate the credits needed to sit for the CPA exam and obtain a license to practice public accounting. The State Board of Accountancy should be contacted to see what courses each individual student need as well as provide additional details on the CPA exam and licensing requirements.

PROFESSIONAL ACCOUNTING CERTIFICATE (PRAC)

Students gain educational training specializing in accounting without having to complete a full Master of Accounting degree. Students must complete four (4) classes (12 credits total) of accounting-focused coursework and earn a grade of "C" or better in each course to receive the Professional Accounting Certificate.

CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION (CPE) CREDITS

Accounting professionals who are CPAs and need continuing professional education (CPE) credits to maintain their public accounting licenses may take these courses to stay up to date on accounting competencies, knowledge, and best practices and earn CPE credits. Students and practitioners should consult the State Board of Accountancy to determine the CPE requirements of their state.

If a student intends to complete the full Professional Accounting Certificate, they will pay \$1,500 for each of the 4 courses, totaling \$6,000 for the certificate.

AVAILABLE COURSES

Students may take one (1) to four (4) courses in the program as needed to fulfill their academic or professional goals.

The following courses are offered on a recurring basis (prerequisite restrictions apply):

Courses Offered in the Fall Semester:

Financial Statement Analysis Concepts and Applications

Analysis of accounting and financial information using published annual reports and other external information sources.

Forensic Accounting and Fraud Examination

An introduction to the theory and practice of forensic accounting with an emphasis on fraud examination. Designed to develop analytical skills that can be utilized by professionals responsible for the prevention, detection and investigation of fraud.

Courses Offered in the Spring Semester:

Accounting Applications in E-Commerce

Coverage of the elements of accounting for e-commerce and supporting technologies. The focus includes the integration of accounting and e-commerce web platforms, accounting analytics, tax and regulatory compliance.

Governmental and Not-for-Profit Accounting Theory

A study of information presented in financial statements/ other reports of governmental units and not-for-profit entities and associated authoritative literature.

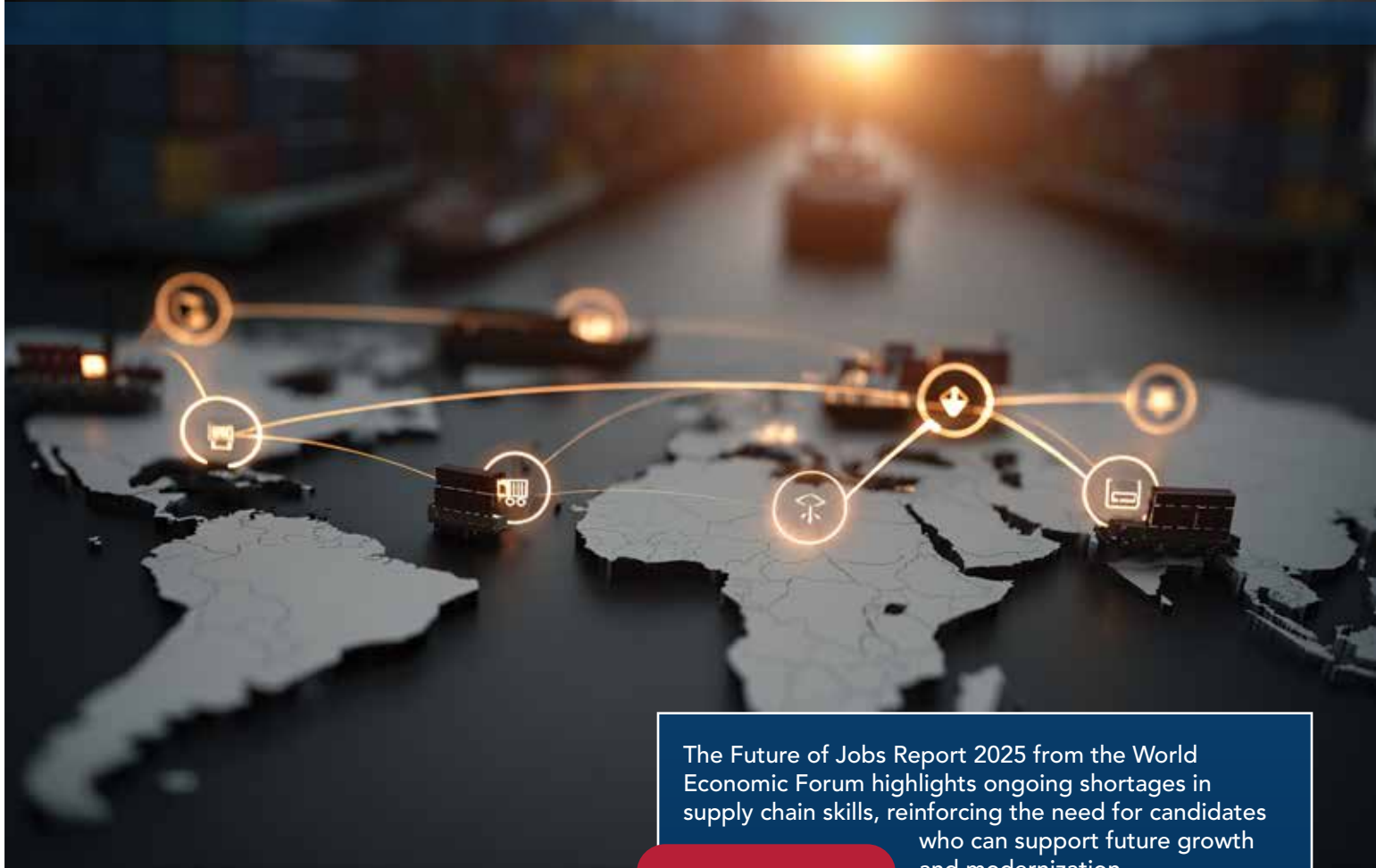

The Iran War, coming amid the fifth year of the Ukraine War and after the COVID-19 pandemic, is only reinforcing the necessity for businesses of shifting back to a paradigm of “just in case” versus “just in time” supply chain management.

This is driving supply chain diversification efforts in general, though some such efforts will take years or decades to manifest, like the slow-going Western campaigns to diversify rare earth supply chains from China. It is also feeding into the revival of industrial policy among Western governments, which aim to secure stable supplies of key resources and manufactured products necessary for functioning economies.

This also makes subsidies, tax breaks, and other industry support measures more likely in the coming years as Western leaders attempt to coopt price-conscious businesses into making supply chain decisions based on resilience, not expedience, which is often an uphill battle. In addition, the increasing frequency and severity of war is making geopolitical risk management into a business necessity, rather than a luxury.

Companies are seeing growing threats to profits from having only operational or logistics teams in some overseas markets, which risks corporate blind spots that result in the failure to predict policy shifts and seemingly “sudden” supply chain disruptions.

As recent disruptions have shown, trade policy, sanctions, industrial policy, and regional conflict now actively reconfigure where and how value is created.

For an orchestrator like Li & Fung, this environment demands a shift from linear, cost-minimizing models to networked, risk-adjusted architectures that integrate friend-shoring, regionalization, and multi-node sourcing.
