Hospitality and Tourism Management Certificate (HSMG)

The undergraduate certificate in Hospitality and Tourism Management provides an industry-focused curriculum for those who desire employment in and/or knowledge of the hospitality and tourism industry – Florida’s #1 private employer and the top global service industry. The certificate in Hospitality and Tourism Management is open to **both degree-seeking and non-degree-seeking** students and is available in person or fully online. Students must complete 15 credits from the courses below. All courses must be completed with a minimum grade of "C."
