

The Hospitality Management minor is offered through the Hospitality & Tourism Management Program in the Department of Marketing. The minor is designed for both business and non-business majors. Students must receive a "C" or better in all minor courses. Students must complete a minimum of 6 credits of upper-division coursework (courses numbered 3000 or 4000) at FAU. https://hospitality.fau.edu

**For Non-Business Majors** (15 credit hours [six courses – one is a 0-credit hour course]) This minor is designed for majors from other colleges or business majors not required to complete the business core (including Health Administration and General Economics) who want to pursue a career in the hospitality industry.

A maximum of 3 credits used for the minor may count toward other Business major requirements. A minimum of two courses (6 credits) must be exclusive to the minor.
