The **Hospitality & Tourism Management** program prepares students for management positions in multiple segments of the world's largest industry. Graduates assume managerial roles in varied hospitality disciplines including: resorts, hotels, restaurants, private clubs, meeting and event planning corporations, destination marketing organizations (DMOs), convention centers, cruise lines, casinos, theme parks, car rental agencies, sports facilities, spas, entertainment venues, and vacation ownership/fractional ownership resorts.

#### **Hospitality & Tourism Management Required Courses**

A minimum 120 credit hours are required for the degree. Other administrative requirements will be needed; see the University Catalog for detailed requirements.

To declare the hospitality and tourism (HTMG) major, students must have: 60 credit hours, a minimum of a 2.5 GPA in the Pre-business Foundation Courses above and completion of the foreign language requirement. Note: A lifetime maximum of three attempts (per course including grades of "W") on any of the Pre-Business Foundation Courses are allowed. Keep in mind, FAU policy states that students many not generally declare a minor, second major, or dual degree after earning 90 credit hours.
