**For Business Majors** (9 credit hours [*four courses – one is a 0-credit hour course*])

Students seeking a major in the College of Business other than Hospitality Management may concurrently earn a minor in Hospitality Management. A maximum of 3 credits used for the minor may count toward other Business major requirements. A minimum of two courses (6 credits) must be exclusive to the minor.
