

Admission Requirements

To be admitted to the program, applicants must have:

- An undergraduate degree in an IT-Related field of study or an undergraduate degree and work experience of two or more years in an IT function. If this requirement is not met, students may need to take one or more foundation courses.
- An undergraduate GPA of 3.0 or higher
- A GMAT score of 500 or higher or GRE score of 1000 or higher
- A satisfactory score in the Test of English as a Foreign Language or the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) for international students
- Met other requirements of the graduate Colleges at FAU.
