The Business Administration minor is designed for Health Administration and General Economics majors, as well as majors outside the College of Business. The minor requires the following seven courses with a grade of "C" or better.

Financial Accounting	ACG 2021 (Pre: 30 credits)
Managerial Accounting	ACG 2071 (Pre: ACG 2021)
Macroeconomics	ECO 2013 (Pre: 30 credits)
Microeconomics	ECO 2023 (Pre: 30 credits)
Mgmt & Organizational Behavior	MAN 3025 (Pre: 60 credits)
Marketing Management	MAR 3023 (Pre: ECO 2013 & 2023, and 60 credits)
Financial Management	FIN 3403 (Pre: ACG 2021 & 2071, and 60 credits)

The three upper-division (3000-level) courses must be taken at FAU. A maximum of 3 credits used for the minor may count toward other Business major requirements. A minimum of two courses (6 credits) must be exclusive to the minor.

Timely Graduation for Undergraduate Students:

All Students must understand that credits earned in excess of those hours required for the degree may be subject to the Excess Hours Surcharge mandated by the State of Florida. The addition of a minor or additional course to their academic portfolio may sound appealing, but it also might result in considerable additional expense and a delay in degree completion.
