The Entrepreneurial Management minor is designed **for non-Business majors** interested in organizing, owning, managing and assuming the risks of a business or assisting organizations in developing new business opportunities. Four courses are required as indicated below, all of which must be completed with a grade of "C" or better.

Required Courses (12 credits)

Entrepreneurship ENT 4024 (Pre: 60hrs)

Advanced Business Planning ENT 4114 (Pre: 60hrs and ENT 4024 with min. of "C" grade)

Entrepreneurial Assistance Project ENT 4934 (Pre: 60hrs, ENT 4024 or permission of instructor; not open to

Economics, International Economics, Health Administration

or Pre-Business majors)

And Select ONE of the courses below:

New Venture Launch ENT 4015 (Pre: ENT 4024 & ENT 4114 with a min. "C" grade, 90 hrs and

permission of instructor)

Entrepreneurship Internship ENT 4940 (Pre: ENT 4024 with min. "C" grade, 90 hrs and permission of

instructor)

At least three of the courses above (9 credits) must be taken in residence at FAU. The acknowledgement of the minor is official upon successful completion of a Florida Atlantic University degree program.

A maximum of 3 credits used for the minor may count toward other Business Major requirements. A minimum of two courses (6 credits) must be exclusive to the minor.

Timely Graduation for Undergraduate Students:

All Students must understand that credits earned in excess of those hours required for the degree may be subject to the Excess Hours Surcharge mandated by the State of Florida. The addition of a minor or additional course to their academic portfolio may sound appealing, but it also might result in considerable additional expense and a delay in degree completion.
