## **International Business Certificate (INBS)**

The Certificate of International Business: Theory and Practice meets the needs of working professionals whose jobs have an international dimension and students who envision a career with an international business component. The certificate is an ideal enhancement to a nondegree seeking professional, an undergraduate business major, or any other academic program. Participants must have at least two years of college or university education and must satisfy the certificate's requirements below. College of business certificates require 100% residency: all courses must be taken at FAU.

To complete the program, students must satisfy the following academic requirements:
