Whether or not your progress towards tenure and promotion is adequate to be awarded tenure and promotion is a question which requires review and assessment at several levels and will take into account departmental, college and institutional needs. A positive or negative appraisal of your progress is not binding on any level of review or recommendation in the tenure and promotion process, and not binding on the President's ultimate decision, but is meant to provide guidance from your department/school.

For the sole purpose of providing assistance and counseling to help you qualify to apply for tenure and promotion, and not for any tenure and promotion decision-making purposes, you are advised that based upon input from your colleagues and my own perception at this point in time, you:
