

## Become an Ambassador

The following information is intended as a general overview of the Student Ambassador Program at FAU's College of Business for prospective ambassadors.

### What We Do

Ambassadors create a welcoming and supportive environment for students, families, and the community. They build community and promote pride within the College of Business by supporting outreach efforts for prospective and current students. Ambassadors provide general information through campus tours and represent the College at campus and community events.

### Qualities of an Ambassador

Ambassadors are driven and adaptable individuals who carry a genuine, positive attitude while representing both themselves and the College with professionalism and strong time-management skills.

### Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Be full-time undergraduate or graduate Business major (minimum 12 credits undergraduate, 9 credits graduate)
- Be in good academic standing
- Have completed at least one semester with two remaining fall/spring semesters before graduation
- Maintain a minimum 3.0 FAU and overall GPA

### Commitment

Ambassadors commit to serving during both fall and spring semesters and participating in required activities and events. They are expected to demonstrate excellent communication skills, a strong work ethic, reliable attendance, and the ability to work both independently and collaboratively in a team environment. Reliable transportation for off-campus events is required.

### Expectations and Opportunities

Ambassadors may:

- Serve as presenters, panelists, and liaisons during events
- Lead VIP tours
- Assist with event planning, administration, and management
- Assist with on- and off-campus recruitment efforts
- Assist with transition support for business students
- Participate in ambassador hiring and training
- Facilitate training sessions on best practices for giving tours
- Create program social media content
- Manage the event calendar to ensure all events are covered

### Work Schedule

Schedules vary. In-person work will generally take place between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday-Friday during the fall and spring semesters, with summer opportunities available. There will be occasional evening or weekend events. Ambassadors must sign up for at least four events per semester.

## **Application Requirements**

Applicants must submit through the online application portal:

- A 300-500 word essay explaining how the Ambassador Program will benefit them
- Two letters of recommendation from FAU faculty or staff
