



College of Business Faculty-led Study Abroad Destination: *La Fortuna / San Jose, Costa Rica*

Explore Costa Rica and study the allocation of resources with a focus on business and economic development. Evaluate the role of the international economy (through the operation of multinational firms and the conduct of international trade and finance), and the importance of cultural differences in business development and practices.

Program Start Date (check-in): Saturday, May 9, 2020

Program End Date (check-out): Saturday, May 16, 2020

Application Deadline: February 3, 2020 or as space permits

Eligibility: Undergraduate (sophomores, juniors, seniors) with a minimum 2.5 overall GPA and graduate students in good academic standing. Prerequisites: ECO 2013 or ECO 2023 or equivalent. Must enroll in one course offering below to participate in the program.

Program Cost: \$2,195 + \$200 FAU administration fee = \$2,395. This includes single occupancy accommodations. A \$250 discount per person is available if you find a participant willing to share a room.

- \$200 FAU administration fee due at time of application submission
- \$300 Non-refundable deposit due by February 7, 2020
- \$1,835 due by March 6, 2020
- \$60 cash payment due at pre-trip meeting on April 25, 2020

Program Cost Includes: Airfare, single occupancy accommodations, international medical insurance, local transportation, daily breakfast, 4 group meals, site admission fees, activities, tours, and lectures.

Not Included: FAU tuition for study abroad course(s) (in-state/out-of-state rates apply), some meals, personal spending money
