

## Entrepreneurial Management Minor (ENTM)

The Entrepreneurial Management minor is designed for students interested in organizing, owning, managing and assuming the risks of a business or assisting organizations in developing new business opportunities.

### Required Courses: 12 credits (Minimum Grade “C”)

\*Some courses may require students to be declared in the minor and receive authorization from a business advisor.

### Additional Requirements

The **minor is open to all degree-seeking students not in business core programs**. This includes non-business majors, Health Administration majors, General Economics majors, and BGS students. Business core majors should pursue the Entrepreneurship Minor (ENT). This minor is not available to Management majors.

A minimum of 9 credits for the minor must be taken at FAU.

### Timely Graduation

Minors and certificates should be considered an optional direction for elective credits. Students may not add a minor or certificate without permission from a COB advisor (and main college advisor if different). Students are generally not permitted to add a minor/cert after earning 90 credit hours or if completing it will result in an Excess Hour Surcharge.

### Maximum Course Attempts

FAU counts a “course attempt” as any time a student is enrolled in a course (at any institution) and earns either a grade or a “W”. FAU COB students may not attempt any course more than twice; **third attempts are not permitted**.
