The Hospitality Management minor is offered through the Hospitality & Tourism Management Program in the Department of Marketing. The minor is designed for both business and non-business majors. Students must receive a "C" or better in all minor courses. Students must complete a minimum of 6 credits of upper-division coursework (courses numbered 3000 or 4000) at FAU.

For Non-Business Majors (15 credit hours [*six courses – one is a 0-credit hour course*])

This minor is designed for majors from other colleges or business majors not required to complete the business core (including Health Administration and General Economics) who want to pursue a career in the hospitality industry.

For Business Majors (9 credit hours [*four courses – one is a 0-credit hour course*])

Students seeking a major in the College of Business other than Hospitality Management may concurrently earn a minor in Hospitality Management. To earn the minor, students must complete 9 credits with a grade of "C" or better from the following courses and must receive an "S" (satisfactory) in HFT 4941. A maximum of 3 credits used for the minor may count toward other Business major requirements. A minimum of two courses (6 credits) must be exclusive to the minor.
