

## Operations Management (OPMN)

The Operations Management minor will provide all Business majors a valuable set of knowledge and skills in process analysis and constraint management, inventory and quality control, service operations, project management, procurement, and supply chain management. Such capabilities are increasingly being sought by employers as they continue to improve their operations in the current cost-constrained, yet increasingly competitive, economic environment.

### Required Courses: 9 credits (Minimum Grade “C”)

Students must choose three courses from the Operations Management options, as indicated in the table below, or two courses from the Operations Management options and one course from Operations Cognate options.

### Additional Requirements

The minor is available to all business majors including students in business core programs, Health Administration majors, and General Economics majors. The minor is not available to BGS or non-business majors. A maximum of 3 credits used for the minor may count toward other business major requirements. A minimum of 6 credits must be exclusive to the minor. A minimum of 9 credits for the minor must be taken at FAU.

### Timely Graduation

Minors and certificates should be considered an optional direction for elective credits. Students may not add a minor or certificate without permission from a COB advisor (and main college advisor if different). Students are generally not permitted to add a minor/cert after earning 90 credit hours or if completing it will result in an Excess Hour Surcharge.

### Maximum Course Attempts

FAU counts a “course attempt” as any time a student is enrolled in a course (at any institution) and earns either a grade or a “W”. FAU COB students may not attempt any course more than twice; **third attempts are not permitted**.
