

Unrestricted Upper Division Business Courses

What does unrestricted mean?

Here, unrestricted means open to students not declared in a business core major. This may include:

- **PBUS:** pre-business students not yet declared in a major
- **BGS:** Bachelor of General Studies students
- **HEAD:** Health Administration majors
- **Gen ECON:** General Economics majors
- **Non-bus:** Non-business students in majors at other FAU colleges

What does upper division business mean?

Courses offered by the College of Business at the 3000 and 4000 level.

Can I choose these courses as electives?

If a course on this list is **NOT** required for your program, then **yes—you CAN use that as an elective**. Courses on this list could potentially count as an upper division business elective, upper division elective, or free elective as appropriate and as long as you meet the pre-requisites. Some courses on this list may be required for your program and would therefore not be electives.

Do not retake a course you have already taken.

Note: Not all courses are offered every semester. Speak with your advisor if you have questions about courses for your degree.

Can COB advisors permit courses not on this list?

No. The only exception is required minor courses that would otherwise be restricted. If a student was approved to declare a minor that requires such a course, a COB advisor can provide a permit.
